Welcome to LJB Badminton Club! Non-Marking court shoes are strictly enforced, please refer to the following information to identify the acceptable shoes.



## Identifying non-marking shoes is simple:

- Check the Sole: Non-marking shoes typically have a light-colored sole, often white or beige. Dark soles may not always be non-marking.
- **Perform the Paper Test:** Rub the sole on white paper. If it leaves a mark, it's not non-marking.
- Look for Labels: Many manufacturers label their shoes as "non-marking" for easy identification.

LJB Badminton Club reserves the right to deny the use of the badminton courts if shoes requirements are not met. A \$200 cleaning fee will be charged to the violators.
